Understand How Your Plan Works

Your health plan includes a feature known as reference-based pricing for covered medical services received at any hospital or other health care facility.

This feature:

- provides you with total freedom of choice of where to receive facility-based care;
- let's you know what your financial responsibility will be before services are provided; and
- takes care of any surprise billing issues after the fact.

You are covered.



For Physician Care

Visit physicians and other nonhospital providers who participate in your PPO network. Log in to *My Plan* to locate a physician in your network.



At Hospitals & Facilities

Receive in- and out-patient hospitalbased care and facility services from any hospital or facility you choose. Your services must be precertified at least 7 days prior to service, so your plan may determine a fair price.

How reference-based pricing works

- Your physician or other health care provider contacts the hospital/facility of your choice to precertify your service at least 7 days before your admission or service.
- The precertification process confirms the total price for services with the hospital or facility based on a reference determined by Medicare. (If the costs are unusually expensive, you'll be notified of other high-quality facilities where you may decide to receive care at lower cost.)
- After you receive your service, the hospital or facility sends HPI a medical claim priced at the agreed upon amount.
- HPI pays the entire claim and will send you an Explanation of Benefits (EOB) only if you are financially responsible for paying a deductible and/or coinsurance amount to the hospital/facility.
- If you receive a balance bill (beyond your financial responsibility), please contact HPI Member Services at the phone number listed on the back of your HPI member ID card. A representative will contact the hospital/facility on your behalf to resolve the issue.
